

ASIST (Applied Suicide Intervention Skills Training)

Pre-event for UCC West Central Regional Youth Event

Suicide touches many lives in many ways. The ASIST training is a world-wide suicide intervention first aid training appropriate for all caregivers, formal or informal. This training (for those age 16 and over) is recognized as a Best Practices skills based training through the National Suicide Prevention Resource Center and is a training program used to train all volunteers through the National Suicide Prevention Lifeline (1-800-273-TALK)

A special training opportunity in ASIST is available to you!

WHAT:

- Full 2-Day program in providing suicide "first-aid" by recognizing an at-risk person, keeping the at-risk person safe, and assisting the person in seeking further help.
- Practice-oriented and interactive learning experience
- Learn how to: recognize invitations for help, reach out and offer support, review the risk of suicide, apply a suicide intervention model, link people with community resources

WHO: People age 16 and over concerned about family, friends; natural helpers and advisers; counselors, teachers, ministers; mental health practitioners; workers in health, welfare, or justice, community volunteers

WHEN: July 12-13, 2010 8:30am – 4:30pm

(Attendance is required for both FULL days; Out-of-towners should plan to arrive on July 11.)

July 14, 2010 8:30 a.m. 2:00pm – Module on lgbt youth suicide

Only individuals who are ASIST Trainers or who have already taken ASIST may register for the lgbt youth suicide module without also taking the full ASIST pre-event. These individuals are responsible for making their own housing arrangements outside of the university.

WHERE: Park University, Parkville, MO

COSTS:

- ✓ ASIST \$35 per person for UCC youth and leaders (July 12-13); \$250 for other (non-UCC) community members
- ✓ LGBT Youth Module \$18 (July 14) (same fee for any participant) (Full participation in ASIST required to take lgbt youth module)
- ✓ Cost of meals
- ✓ Cost of lodging – If at Park University, the following options are available:
 1. \$20/night for a shared room (\$60 total for nights of July 11-13)
 2. \$30/night for a single room (\$90 total for nights of July 11-13)
